NOTICE OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION OF A MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE LANDFILL PERMIT UNDER THE ALABAMA SOLID WASTES AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS MANAGEMENT ACT AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

PERRY COUNTY

Perry County Associates, LLChas submitted to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management an application to modify the solid waste disposal facility permit for the **Arrowhead Landfill (Permit 53-03)**. The Arrowhead Landfill is located in Sections 21, 22, 27, and 28, Township 17 North, Range 6 East in Perry County, Alabama. The proposed modification would increase the disposal acreage from 256.151 acres to 425.33 acres (Tract 1 would be 117.63 acres, Tract 2 would be 159.28 acres, and Tract 3 would be 148.42 acres). The proposed modification would result in an increase of 169.179 acres of permitted disposal acreage. The permitted facility would remain 976.97 acres.

The waste stream for the Arrowhead Landfill would remain nonhazardous solid wastes, noninfectious putrescible and nonputrescible wastes including but not limited to household garbage, commercial waste, industrial waste, construction and demolition debris, tires, other similar type materials, and special waste approved by ADEM. The service area for the Arrowhead Landfill would remain the States of Alabama, Arkansas, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wisconsin. The maximum average daily volume of waste disposed at the Arrowhead Landfill would remain 15,000 tons per day.
